



VISITOR ACCESS POLICY

Visitors must present a government-issued photo ID card or passport to access the library and sign in and out with a security guard or library staff. An image of a photo ID is not permitted. Persons under the age of 18 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult caregiver. Visitors are welcome to use open study areas and are required to leave by 9pm.

Visitor access to designated public desktop computers may be provided upon request and proof of identification. The University Library reserves the right to limit the amount of time a visitor can occupy a computer and to give preference to GSU students, faculty, and staff. The library strictly enforces federal, state, local, and university rules governing use of computer resources and behavior in public spaces.

Visitor@GSU Wi-Fi allows you to access most of our databases and other online resources. Licensing agreements prohibit remote access. Members of the community may purchase a Community Borrower Card for \$30 to borrow 5 books from the general collection for 4 weeks with 2 renewals. The card is valid for 365 days from the purchase date.
