



VISITOR ACCESS POLICY – ATLANTA CAMPUS

The University Library at the Atlanta campus welcomes visitors (non-GSU affiliated users) every hour that we are open, including weekends, until 9:00 p.m. Only currently enrolled students, faculty, and staff of Georgia State University are permitted to remain in the building after 9:00 p.m., whenever the library is scheduled to be open past 9:00 p.m.

Visitors are required to provide a current university or government-issued photo ID card or passport and sign in and out with a security guard. All library patrons are required to abide by the [University Library Conduct Policy](#), which is strictly enforced. Policy violations are documented and handled promptly.

During the week prior to final examinations and during the final examination period, access during all hours is restricted to:

- currently enrolled students, faculty, and staff of Georgia State University;
- guests accompanied by a GSU faculty or staff member with valid ID;
- current GSU Alumni Association members with valid ID;
- GSU campus tours; and
- Visitors who have made special arrangements with library administration.
