



UNIVERSITY LIBRARY CLASSROOMS USE POLICY

Library classrooms are designated for the delivery of instruction by library personnel. Library instruction and training sessions have priority over all other uses.

At the Atlanta Campus, when no instruction or training sessions have been scheduled, Classrooms 1 and 2 may be made available to Georgia State University students as overflow spaces. Students will be asked to vacate classrooms 15 minutes prior to the start of a scheduled classroom session.

While Library instruction and training take priority, the Library will consider requests from other University groups or departments wishing to use its classrooms on a case-by-case basis.
