**Purpose:** To support the curricular and research needs of the Department of Kinesiology and Health. Degrees offered by the Department include: Bachelor of Science in Exercise Science, Bachelor of Science in Education in Health and Physical Education, Master of Science in Exercise Science, Master of Science in Sports Administration, Master of Science in Sports Medicine, Master of Education in Health and Physical Education, Doctor of Philosophy in Kinesiology (available with Biomechanics, Exercise Physiology, and Physical Rehabilitation Science concentrations).

**General Collection Guidelines:**

- a. Language: English is the primary language of selection.
- b. Chronological Guidelines: Emphasis is on health and physical education, sports administration & management, exercise & sport sciences, and orthopedics in the 20<sup>th</sup> century and beyond. However, historical treatments are added as needed.
- c. Geographical Guidelines: Primary emphasis is within the United States. However, other countries are added as needed.
